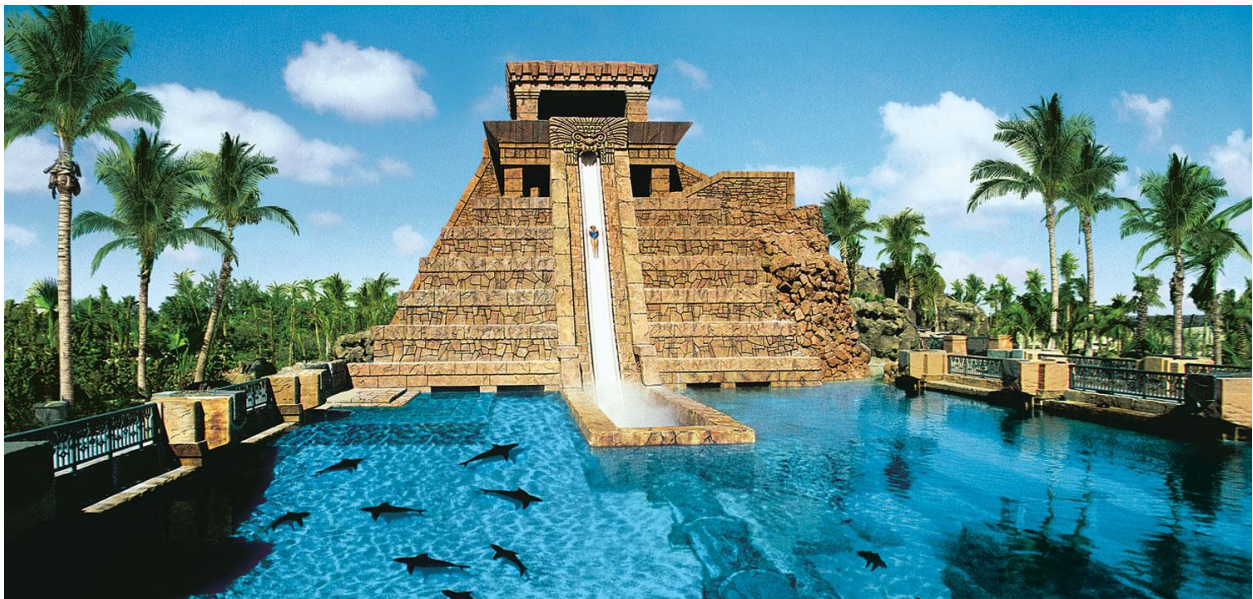


For more than four decades Cloward H2O has been privileged to participate in design and engineering of thousands of aquatic projects spanning virtually every aspect of Aquatic Attractions ranging from the simplest of fountains to large man-made lakes and river systems, hotel amenity pools to full scale waterparks, and individual aquarium tanks to some of the largest aquarium facilities in the world. Throughout our years in business we have had the pleasure of forming many lasting friendships and wonderful partnerships with the people and firms that we have worked with all over the world. We have learned that providing excellent services and quality material always pays off in the long run. Looking back at how well some of our most iconic projects have endured through time demonstrates this lesson.

Cloward H2O is currently celebrating 10 years since the full three phase build-out of Atlantis Paradise Island in the Bahamas and Atlantis, the Palm in Dubai were completed.



Atlantis Paradise Island opened the doors with phase one in 1994, raising the bar for resorts and outdoor amenities for the resort hospitality industry and continued to set the standard higher with each subsequent expansion. Phase two added more than 6 million gallons of aquarium attractions holding 50,000 animals in an immersive ancient Atlantean-themed environment along with many amazing swimming pools and slides

including the iconic “Leap of Faith”. This slide was developed as first-of-its kind in the world, dropping riders more than 60 ft. from the top of a Mayan Pyramid to shoot through the shark tank in clear acrylic slide sections. Phase three added the full package with Aquaventure and Dolphin Cay.



Aquaventure is a one-of-a-kind, 141-acre waterscape adding more pools, a downhill action river with rapids, tidal surges and various other effects. This non-stop aquatic playground features over twenty million



gallons of water, magnificent themed towers housing high-speed water slides, a mile-long river ride with rolling rapids and wave surges, a spectacular kids’ water-play fort and 11 refreshing swimming pools. Dolphin Cay is an 11-acre, 6 million gallon, interactive dolphin lagoon

complete with coves and sandy beaches, 7 connected "residential" pools, a state-of-the-art education center, an animal rescue-rehabilitation hospital, an animal pharmacy, quarantine, and a separate sea lion center.

On the other side of the world the team was concurrently working on Atlantis The Palm, situated on the newly created man-made Palm Island in Dubai. The resort opened in 2008, mirroring in one



go what took three phases and 15 years to complete in the Bahamas, immediately becoming both the largest aquarium and largest waterpark in the middle east. This incredible facility includes attractions such as the Tower of Neptune and the Tower of Poseidon packed with thrilling water slides, 1.5 km of downhill rapids river adventure, a water playground for younger guests, and yes, the Dubai equivalent of the Leap of Faith slide from across the globe, complete with sharks.
